He trained in General Medicine, Medical Oncology and holds a PhD in Clinical Pharmacology. He worked in the Netherlands for 25 years where, among others, he was the founder of the first Dutch Hospice, Hospice Rozenheuvel in Rozendaal. He is the author of more than 130 papers, several books and numerous chapters in textbooks, printed in three languages. In 2006 he was decorated by HM the Queen Beatrix of the Netherlands with an Officers Cross in the order of Orange Nassau. Areas of interest: pruritus in cancer, opioids pharmacology, opioid induced hyperalgesia and end-of-life-ethics
