# Last year those of you who volunteer in our income generation teams helped achieve amazing things:

**Retail:** The Retail Division once again generated more funds than ever before, raising **over £6 million!** We sold **1,835,379** items of clothing, up **4.71%** on last year with an average basket price rise of 16p (3.19%) to **£4.91!** 

We recruited **3438** new Gift Aiders in 2024/25 and made our largest annual Gift Aid claim of **£408,000**.

The scanning books with World of Books has generated an additional £22,000 since we started. Pennies donations on card transactions raised £24,968. Keep the change donations in shops totalled £12,821

**Fundraising:** Fundraising secured a record-breaking total of almost £1.2 million! Highlights this year included 58 schools/nurseries participating in the Santa Run and raising over £64,000, the first Pub to Pub walk raising over £10,000 and the return of the Night Walk raising over £26,000!

**Lottery:** Your Charity Lottery ended the year having raised **£1.1 million** and despite a difficult year for canvassing, **3,613** new members were recruited.

**Nurseries:** Little Owls Day Nurseries enjoyed another successful year in 2024/5, caring for over **300** children across our Dove House and Ainthorpe locations. We welcomed over 50 new starters to our Ainthorpe nursery and Little Owls site at the hospice had a phenomenal year generating a almost £1.1 million in income.

# Have you seen our Volunteer Recruitment campaign?

June saw us kick start one of the biggest volunteer recruitment campaigns the hospice has undertaken!

The campaign has included:

- Radio campaign on Nation Radio Yorkshire which was heard by 51,430 listeners an average of 10.14 times each. With further radio adverts booked.
- Leaflets distributed to 31,255 households.
- 3 bus stop adverts.
- 10 bus interior panel adverts.
- Article and social media promotion on Hull Live.
- Facebook and Instagram digital campaigns seen 218,809 times by 68,636 social media accounts.
- Updates to the Volunteering pages on the Dove House website.
