Event Terms & Conditions

Get Caked – Saturday 16th March 2019, Sledmere House

In addition to signing these terms and conditions, I understand that I must also read and sign a Waiver Agreement document and return it on the day of the event. Failure to do so will result in me not being able to take part in Get Caked!.

1. I understand that the minimum age for entry in to Get Caked! is 15 years of age. I acknowledge that 15-17 year old participants must be accompanied by a registered participating adult, who must take full responsibility for them throughout the Get Caked! event and must read and sign these General Terms and Conditions and a Waiver Agreement Document on their behalf. I understand that one participating adult may take responsibility for up to three 15-17 year olds.
2. I understand that I must commit to individually raising a minimum of £50 sponsorship for Dove House Hospice to help local people with life limiting illnesses and agree to not only do this, but to endeavour to raise even more.
3. I understand that I can participate in Get Caked! as part of a team; however I must raise the minimum sponsorship amount stated individually.
4. I understand that my start time corresponds with the wave time that I selected upon registration and that it may not be possible to change this once I've registered. Should I need to change my wave (start time) I must contact the Dove House Hospice events team as soon as possible.
5. I understand that I must wear my Get Caked! t-shirt on the day of the event and my Runner number must be clearly visible on my t-shirt at all times.
6. I understand and confirm that I will wear appropriate shoes and suitable sports clothing (preferably long sports trousers to avoid scratches, bites & bruises) and understand that due to the nature of the Get Caked! event, my clothing may get damaged.
7. I acknowledge that if I arrive late and miss my start time, I may not be permitted to participate, and this decision will be at the discretion of Event Organisers.
8. I understand that Dove House Hospice reserves the right to cancel, alter timings, reschedule and change event logistics at any time and that this decision is at the discretion of The Event Organisers.
